Description of Requirements:

UNMIL seeks to engage the services of qualified companies for the provision of Antenna Towers; specifically to install, commission and maintain Microwave radio antennas (point to point links) and VHF radio repeaters within Liberia for UNMIL. These structures would form an integral part of the communications infrastructure that provide critical support to the UNMIL missions' operational requirements, and must be reliable in order to handle the expected requirements of the Missions.

1. Companies responding to this EOI must :
 - Confirm that they are willing and capable to provide the required services above;
 - Provide copies of business registration and licenses as applicable, to perform the required services;
 - Provide latest financial statement demonstrating sufficient financial solidity to enter into a contract for the required services;
 - Provide detailed company profile demonstrating sufficient experience in the provision of the required services;
 - Provide written references from major clients on past performance.
2. Expression of interest not addressing the above criteria to the satisfaction of UNMIL shall not be considered for invitation to tender. Companies interested in being considered for invitation to the tender must submit a written Expression of Interest, including the information requested above.
