## **Description of Main Duties:**

**Responsibilities:** Within delegated authority, the Telecommunications Technician will be responsible for the following duties:

- Takes the lead in the installation of VHF, UHF and HF Mobile, base stations and repeaters, rural telephone links, trunking radio systems, antennas and related equipment; programming of radios, preventive and corrective maintenance on various types of radio;
- Coordinates the erection of antenna masts and towers;
- Coordinates the training of non-technical radio users on the operation of handheld portable radios, mobile radios, base stations and related equipment;
- Supervises the setup, configuration and testing of the various digital radio systems utilizing a wide range of specialized and complex test equipment; Coordinates the programming, testing and commissioning of new equipment prior to deployment;
- Plans the deployment, dismantling of relevant antennas and feeder lines on communications towers and masts;
- Performs other related duties as required.
- Oversees the installation of auxiliary equipment such as power supplies, solar power systems, UPS units, Voltage Regulators, DC converters and various protection and remote control systems;
- Supervises the gathering of specifications for the procurement of equipment, spares and supplies;
- Ensures that all the required spare parts and supplies are in place so as to minimise downtimes;
- Coordinates regularly scheduled and preventative and corrective maintenance on telecommunications installations and equipment.

## **Competencies:**

**Planning and Organizing**: Ability to manage a large volume of work in an efficient and timely manner, ability to work under pressure, with conflicting deadlines.

**Teamwork and respect for diversity**: Ability to establish and maintain effective partnerships and respect for diversity and gender;
